The only requirement for HA membership is a desire to be free from homosexuality.

While HA encourages its members to be active in their local church, its program is non-sectarian and non-denominational. It does not endorse or oppose any political causes, nor does it wish to engage in any controversial issues that would draw member's energies away from the goal of maturing in their relationships with those around them and rediscovering their true identity through a restored relationship with God through Jesus Christ.

DEAR NEW HA MEMBER:

Welcome to this fellowship of men and women who are helping each other find freedom from homosexuality. This is not a place for sexual contacts or for the experience of cheap thrills. It is a place where you should find support and an ever increasing recovery from homosexuality.

We know that you have probably come from a life experience of deep pain and possible sexual abuse. We share your grief with you and we also want you to know that people who have been abused are often not aware that their experience was in fact abuse. Sometimes it come by a tone of voice, sometimes by a look, a suggestive style of clothing or an inappropriate touch.

If in your HA experience you have uncertainties about your relationships with members or with your step coach in these areas, we encourage you to bring to the person involved directly. If you should ever be asked to engage in improper behavior or be inappropriately touched, please discuss the problem with senior members of your HA group. We do not believe in blame or condemnation nor in casting anyone out of our group who desires to be free. All that we ask is that you join with us in helping each other confront our problems and learn to live in freedom from homosexuality together.
